# AVAILABLE SERVICES

**Material Types:** Businesses are offered weekly collection services for garbage and recyclable materials. Businesses producing 4 cubic yards or more of garbage per week are required by the state to participate in a recycle program (AB341). Collection services are also available for mixed construction waste and demolition debris (C&D).

**Collection Frequency:** All services are available up to five (5) times per week and not less than once per week depending on area. On Call services are also available with a minimum of a 4yd bin depending on collection area.

**Extra Pick-ups:** Collection services are available on days other than regularly scheduled collection day(s) for an additional charge. Extra pick-ups are scheduled at the customer's request, up to five(5) days of service per week. To schedule an extra pick-up, please contact Customer Service at 209-274-ACES.



# COLLECTION INFORMATION

**Service Locations:** ACES can accommodate collection locations for businesses based on customer preference, accessibility and space constraints. If the service location is not immediately accessible or if unique conditions or special requests are made, additional charges may apply. To determine whether your collection location or needs incur additional charges, please contact Customer Service at 209-274-ACES.

**Collection and Set-out Time:** All containers must be placed in the designated collection location or made accessible for collection no later than 3:00am on the regular collection day. Containers placed curbside should be returned to the appropriate enclosure promptly following collection. A return trip fee will apply if containers were not accessible for collection.

**Extra Materials:** Materials that are placed out for collection beyond the capacity of the container or are overfilled will be collected. Additional charges will be applied based on the volume of excess material collected. Please contact Customer Service in advance before setting out extra materials.

**Holiday Observance:** Collection will not occur on New Year's Day (January 1<sup>st</sup>), or Christmas Day (December 25<sup>th</sup>). If an observed holiday falls on a regular collection day, collection for the remainder of the week will be delayed by one day. Regular collection will resume the following week.

# COLLECTION RATES

**Collection Costs:** Costs for collection of garbage and recyclable materials vary depending on the level of service requested and area. Additional services are available for an additional charge, as described below.

**Monthly Rates:** Weekly collection service rates are based on the material type, container size and frequency of collection. Services are provided weekly and customers are billed monthly.

**Per-Service Rates:** All services for debris boxes and compactors are charged on a per service basis. Charges include hauling and disposal fees.

**Difficult to Service:** ACES offers extra services to facilitate collection for an additional charge. Services may include, but are not limited to: opening and closing gates, pushing and/or pulling containers, locking and/or unlocking container enclosures, or performing other services as reasonably necessary to access and empty containers.

**Service Requests:** Service changes, collection of additional materials and collection of materials on a day other than the regular scheduled collection day can only be requested by persons authorized on the account. Additional charges may apply.

# COLLECTION CONTAINERS

**Carts and Bins:** ACES provides containers in 32, 64 and 96 gallon carts and 2,3,4, and 6 cubic yard bins. Bins are either on wheels or skids.

# GO GREEN - GOOD FOR BUSINESS

## Regulatory Requirements

The State of California has passed legislation requiring businesses subscribe to recycling and organics collection services. The purpose of the legislation is to reduce materials sent to landfills and reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

## Mandatory Commercial Recycling

California Assembly Bill 341 (AB341) became effective July 1, 2012, mandating recycling for all businesses in California producing 4 cubic yards or more of garbage per week and multi-family dwellings with 5 or more units. Subscribing to recycle materials collection services through ACES will help ensure compliance with AB341.

## HOW TO COMPLY

ACES offers a free 96 gallon Recycle cart to commercial customers who generate 4 or more cubic yards of waste per week. Recycle bins are also available in 2yd, 3yd, 4yd and 6yd.

Place recyclable materials loosely inside your recycle cart or bin. All items must fit completely inside the container with the lid closed. Additional cardboard must be bundled (no larger than 3x3) and placed next to the recycle container.

## MOTOR OIL & FILTERS

Motor oil can be poured into special receptacles located at both the Buena Vista and Pine Grove Transfer Stations. Oil Filters can be placed in the gray box next to the oil receptacle to drain. Both oil and filters can be taken to either transfer station during regular hours.

## CARPET RECYCLING

Clean carpet can be recycled at the Buena Vista transfer station at a discounted tonnage rate. Carpet needs to be in manageable lengths and rolled, clear of tack strips. Padding should be rolled separately.

## HAZARDOUS WASTE

These items CANNOT be placed inside containers.

- Auto & brake fluids
- Batteries
- Cleaning fluids
- Electronic waste
- Fire extinguishers
- Fluorescent light bulbs (e.g CFLs, tubes)
- Fuel tanks - with valve on (e.g helium)
- Medications (unused or expired)
- Mercury thermometers/thermostats
- Paints & stains (e.g oil/solvent based)
- Pesticides & fertilizers
- Pool & spa chemicals
- Syringes/sharps

# DEBRIS BOXES & MINI BINS

ACES offers temporary and permanent debris box and mini bin collection services for large quantities. Services on customer provided stationary compactors ranging in size 20 to 40 cubic yards are also available. Debris boxes can be ordered for materials including:

- Recyclable materials
- Landscaping
- Concrete
- Construction & demolition
- Solid waste

## Debris boxes

Containers for household and construction debris are available in 20, 30 & 40 cubic yard sizes. For heavy materials or concrete work, we offer a 10 cubic yard box, it's low profile is easy to load and smaller size helps to prevent overloading the box. Rentals for the debris boxes are seven days.

**20yd: 18' x 8' x 4.5'**

**30yd: 22' x 8' x 5'**

**40yd: 22' x 8' x 6'**

## Compactors:

Maintenance services for compactors are available for an additional fee. ACES can also provide a list of known vendors and specifications for customers interested in purchasing compactors, to ensure compatibility with collection vehicles. If required, compactors can be priced and negotiated.

## Mini bins

Containers are available in 3 & 6 cubic yard sizes and are great for smaller jobs.
