SPRING CLEAN-UP, MAY 8 - 12

Within city limits of Ione, Jackson, Plymouth & Sutter Creek: Residential Spring Clean-up, on your regular pick-up day. All trash must be bagged, boxed, or bundled in a throw-away container. No single item may exceed 50 pounds or 4 feet in length.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Memorial Day: Normal collection, Office & Transfer Stations closed.

Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off:

May 6, 20; June 3, 17; July 8, 22.

At the Buena Vista Transfer Station, Ione, 9 am - 1 pm. Free, up to 15 gallons or 125 lbs per trip.

Summer Transfer Station Hours:

Starting Mar. 12, Buena Vista Transfer Station hours changed to 9 am - 5 pm.
