New Rules for Residential Cardboard Recycling

ACES has changed the rules for customer cardboard recycling with the goal of improving driver safety and efficiency while working with ever-changing recycling markets.

The new requirements for disposing of residential cardboard are reducing the number of times drivers have to exit their trucks to pick up extras and clean up litter.

An extra material charge for cardboard (or other recycling) that exceeds the following guidelines helps cover the cost of processing and sending these materials to a recycling facility (ACES pays recyclers to take your recycling, not the other way around).

<u>Please read the following information carefully so that</u> you aren't surprised by extra charges on your bill.

DURING RECYCLE WEEKS ONLY:

- **32-gallon recycle cart customers** are allowed <u>one</u> <u>2'x2'x2' bundle of extra cardboard outside the cart</u>, anything more will result in an extra material charge.
- **64- and 96-gallon recycle cart customers** must <u>place</u> <u>everything in the cart</u>. Any extra recycling or cardboard outside of the cart will result in an extra material charge.

• 64-gallon blue lid recycle cart customers with orange bags must <u>place everything in the cart</u>. Any extra recycling or cardboard outside of the cart will result in an extra material charge.

• Orange bag customers without carts are allowed_ <u>one 2'x2'x2' bundle of extra</u> <u>cardboard</u> at no charge, anything more is extra. (These customers may use 2 orange bags per week



Fall Clean-Up, Oct. 9 -13 Within City Limits of Ione, Jackson, Sutter Creek & Plymouth:

Residential Fall Clean-up will be the week of **October 9 -13.** ACES provides customers within city limits of lone, Jackson, Sutter Creek and Plymouth one free extra pick-up (up to one cubic yard, 3'x3'x3', or about seven 32-gallon bags) on normal pickup days. <u>All general trash and yard waste must</u> <u>be bagged, boxed, or bundled in a throw-away container.</u> No single item may exceed 50 pounds or 4 feet in length. **Acceptable materials include:** Paper products, general trash, wood, tools, metal, plastics, yard waste. **Unacceptable materials include:** Appliances, furniture,

mattresses, tires, electronic waste (TV's, computers, etc.), motor oil, rock, dirt, concrete, paint, hot ashes, animal waste, household hazardous waste.
