New Rules for Residential Cardboard Recycling

ACES has changed the rules for customer cardboard recycling with the goal of improving driver safety and efficiency while working with ever-changing recycling markets.

The new requirements for disposing of residential cardboard are reducing the number of times drivers have to exit their trucks to pick up extras and clean up litter.

An extra material charge for cardboard (or other recycling) that exceeds the following guidelines helps cover the cost of processing and sending these materials to a recycling facility (ACES pays recyclers to take your recycling, not the other way around).

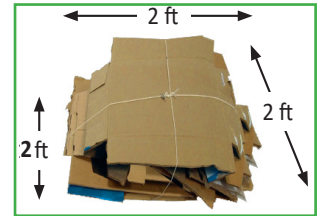
Please read the following information carefully so that you aren't surprised by extra charges on your bill.

DURING RECYCLE WEEKS ONLY:

- **32-gallon recycle cart customers** are allowed one 2'x2'x2' bundle of extra cardboard outside the cart, anything more will result in an extra material charge.
- **64- and 96-gallon recycle cart customers** must place everything in the cart. Any extra recycling or cardboard outside of the cart will result in an extra material charge.

- **64-gallon blue lid recycle cart customers with orange bags** must place everything in the cart. Any extra recycling or cardboard outside of the cart will result in an extra material charge.

- **Orange bag customers without carts** are allowed one 2'x2'x2' bundle of extra cardboard at no charge, anything more is extra. (These customers may use 2 orange bags per week and may request a 64-gallon cart if they wish.)

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE & MORE

Veterans Day: Normal collection and Transfer Station hours. Office closed.

Thanksgiving: Normal collection. ACES office will be closed Thursday & Friday. Transfer Stations closed on Thursday.

Christmas & New Year's Day: No collection, Office & Transfer Stations closed. Since Christmas Day and New Years Day fall on a Monday, customers with Monday collection will be serviced on Tuesday, Tuesday customers serviced on Wednesday, etc. Friday customers will be serviced on Saturday. The week of Jan. 8, everyone reverts back to their regular collection day.

Transfer Station Hours Change:

Nov. 5 through Mar. 9, Buena Vista Transfer Station hours change from 9 am - 5 pm to 8:30 am - 4:30 pm.

Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off:

Nov. 4 - 18; Dec. 2, 16; Jan. 6, 20

At the Buena Vista Transfer Station, lone, 9 am - 1 pm. Free, up to 15 gallons or 125 lbs per trip.

Free Christmas Tree Recycling:

Dec. 26, 2023 - Jan. 31, 2024.

Trees (all ornaments and lights removed) can be dropped off at the Westover Field airport parking lot Dec 26 - Jan 31. Throughout the month of January, trees can also be dropped off at either the Buena Vista Transfer Station daily from 8:30 am - 4:30 pm, or the Pine Grove Transfer Station, Tues. through Sat., 9:00 am - 12 pm & 1:00 - 4:00 pm. The Christmas trees are then recycled locally at the Vicini Brothers Green Waste Recycling Facility and turned into landscape mulch and nutrient rich compost.
