ACES Curbside Recycling Collection Service -- What's In & What's Out?

Whether you have a Recycle Cart or Orange Bags, please follow the guidelines below for what to recycle with ACES....

ACCEPTABLE

- All colors of glass food & beverage containers
- Aluminum or tin cans (please remove lids & rinse)
- Plastic bottles, jugs & jars
- Newspapers and any inserts that come with it
- White and colored paper
- Computer paper
- Junk Mail
- Brown paper grocery bags
- Post-it notes
- Window envelopes
- Paper egg cartons
- Flattened cereal/cracker/shoe boxes (plastic liners removed)

UNACCEPTABLE

- Dirty Aluminum Foil
- Dirty Pizza Boxes
- Food or moisture contaminated paper products such as paper plates, cups, napkins, towels & tissues
- Waxed juice boxes or milk cartons
- Ceramics, Pyrex, window glass, mirrors or light bulbs, dishes, safety or auto glass
- Non-container plastic such as plastic bags, plastic wrap, hoses, toys, plastic plates, cups, straws
- Styrofoam cups, food trays, or packing material
- Rag clothes
- Packaging, liners, paper dishware or utensils




New Trash Cans for Jackson Main Street

When the businesses on Jackson's historic Main Street asked ACES to help replace the aging and inconvenient trash cans on Main Street, ACES' staff said, "Of course!"

Jackson Main Street sidewalks are narrow, so a space-saving receptacle was needed. Also needed was a rain-proof, anchorable container with a rigid liner (no trash bags to reduce plastic waste). ACES' staff worked with Jackson businesses to find the right trash cans for Main Street and then donated the 12 new trash receptacles last fall ... and they look great!
